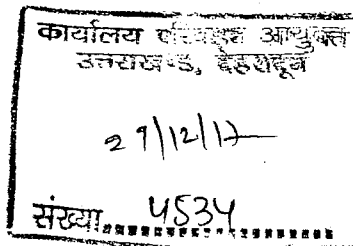

Subject: Road Safety Audit

Sir,

The Committee has issued various directions to the States/UTs from time to time to strengthen institutional arrangements to promote road safety and implement laws and best practices by way of enforcement, engineering, education and emergency care. One of these directions relates to the road safety audit. The Committee had directed that all new road projects costing more than Rs 10 crores should be undertaken only after the design stage audit is conducted and the recommendations of the Auditor are implemented.

2. Attention is invited to the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 30th November, 2107, wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has ordered that the design stage audit of new road projects should be of 5 km or more, rather than being based on the cost of the project. The direction of the Committee should accordingly be read as follows:

'All new road projects of 5 km or more should be undertaken only after the design stage audit is conducted and the recommendations of the Auditor are implemented'
